This highly recognised award is made to the authors of the paper judged by peer scholars as the best presented at the conference. The awards are open to research scientist and faculty from any nationality. Any scientist relevant to wound care will be eligible, including (but not limited to) regenerative medicine, podiatry, tissue science, tissue engineering, plastic surgeries, biomaterials, tissue repair or various hybrids. Awardees will be selected based on need and submission quality.

Best Poster Award

The Best Poster awards are awarded at the Conference Series conferences for the best titles portrayed by Faculty / PhD students / Post Docs. A combination of excellent research, project creativity, innovation, and way of representation is rewarded. The expert panel will review each poster session.

Awardees are chosen on site (posters not attended will not be accepted at their scheduled time) and award winners will be announced during the meeting. Both awards include an International Organizing Committee approved certificate of recognition. In the relevant Conference Series journal, each best poster winner will receive a 70 percent reduction in the manuscript publication.
