AAEWMR during this year also brought out a supplement to Jan-Feb 2020 issue, which consisted of 1 abstracts of an international conference on Environment. Besides AAEWMR will also bring out an online special issue in 2020. AAEWMR is a good journal for the new researcher among all journals in the field of environmental Science published in world wide. During the calendar year 2019-20, AAEWMR received a total of 3 papers, every articles were accepted in the preliminary screening due to plagiarism or being out of the format. During 2019-20 all articles were subjected to the peer-review process and all of those were accepted. In the 3 or 1 issues of Volume 2 or volume 3 published during the year 2019-20, a total of 3+ articles were published of which, 90 % articles were by foreign authors. A total of 30+ research scientists from abroad reviewed the 20 articles published in volume 1-3. Average publication lag time of an article was further reduced to 6-8 weeks.
