All published articles of this journal are included in the indexing and

abstracting coverage of CAS Source Index (CASSI), Index Copernicus, Google Scholar, Sherpa Romeo, Academic Journals Database, Genamics JournalSeek, JournalTOCs, CiteFactor, Electronic Journals Library, RefSeek, Hamdard University, EBSCO A-Z, Directory of Abstract Indexing for Journals, World Catalogue of Scientific Journals, OCLC- WorldCat, Scholarsteer, SWB online catalog, Publons, Dtu findit

Studies receiving funding from a funding organization that is included on the list of PMC and Research Funder Policies or authors having NIH grant were submitted to PubMed (NLM Unique ID: 101511907).

During the calendar year 2019, Journal of Computer Science and Systems Biology received a total of 27 papers, out of which 8 articles were rejected in the preliminary screening due to plagiarism or being out of the format and peer review process. During 2019 around 10 articles were subjected for publication after they are accepted in the peer review process. In the 1,2,3,4 issues of Volume 3 published during the year 2019, a total of 17 articles were published (at an

average of 3 articles per issue) of which, articles were published from authors all around the world.

Journal of Materials Science and Nanotechnology also announces its new association with allied academies Publishers for Archiving, Journal maintenance, financial purpose and support. However the journal will be running its original website <https://www.alliedacademies.org/journal-materials-science-research-nanotechnology/> parallel for Editorial and review work process so as to maintain its highest standard of scientific work.

During the calendar year 2019, a total of two Editors, twenty Reviewers joined the board of AAMSN and contributed their valuable services towards contribution as well as publication of articles, and their valuable reviewer comments will be beneficial to publish quality of article in the Journal.
