A poster is a visual representation of your research that you may show to an audience. The Allied Academies conference provides a one-of-a-kind creative opportunity to do so.

Benefits of poster presentations:

- Poster presentations provide a unique chance to mix visual and oral descriptions of your efforts.
- Top Poster Award: At the conference's closing event, three best awards will be presented.
- CROSSREF will publish the accepted abstract in reputable and supported international publications with a unique DOI number.
- The best posters will be offered the chance to publish their whole work in one of the supporting international journals.

The winner will be chosen based on:

- The following criteria will be used to judge posters; those are presenting style (5), research quality (5), and layout/design (5).
- Presentation clarity of poster and oral explanation will be used to choose the winner.
- The overall answer to the questions, as well as the thoroughness of the work, is judged by the poster.

Guidelines for Posters:

• The poster should be 40" x 59" (1X1.5 Sq.Mts) in size.

• Organize your content proportionally by dividing your poster into three or four pieces (vertically or horizontally) and placing your content within those parts.

- Make use of huge text.
- Colors should be chosen with care, and contrast should be considered.
- Cropping, Margins, and Spacing: Make sure all of the edges and margins are straight and even.
- White Space: There is no writing or graphics on them.

The information should be included on posters:

- Title
- Introduction
- Methods
- Results
- Conclusion
- References
- Acknowledgements
- Contact Information

Posters should elicit conversation rather than providing a lengthy exposition. As a result, limit text to a minimum, accentuate images, and double-check that each item on your poster is required.

• The posters will be printed using a high-quality link.

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- During a poster presentation, no laptops or other assistance are permitted.
- Your poster presentation should last 15 minutes for each visitor/judge.
- A maximum of two people can present each poster.
- Allow another scientist to observe your posters rather than standing right in front of them.

• Use tube packing or a portfolio case to transport your poster to the conference. Your poster should not be mailed to the conference headquarters or the meeting location.
