

Main improvements in our post bariatric surgical practice

Abstract

Post bariatric surgery works by different interventions involving ten anatomical sites, face lift can be added apart. The ten anatomical sites are listed in the Pittsburgh Rating Scale; the operations are performed on the abdomen, the lower back, the thighs, the upper back, the arms and the breast. Our traditional interventions are liposuction, lower transverse abdominoplasty (with the variant of reverse abdominoplasty), abdominoplasty fleur de lys, gluteoplasty, thighplasty (short and long), brachioplasty, dorsal dermolipectomy (vertical and bra line, mastopexy/boomerang mastectomy (in the male).

We began to use four new different interventions; our thighplasty was made in “L” shape, now is only vertical; we put together the intervention of brachioplasty and the vertical dermolipectomy of the back; in selected cases we substituted fleur de lys abdominoplasty with bilateral thoracoplasty and classic abdominoplasty (in order to avoid obvious scars), we exploited the technique of Jean François Pascal in order to correct both gluteal region and lateral thighs when needed.

Some of these improvements are combinations of preexisting techniques, some are simplifications, some are our new techniques, some are others' techniques.

In each technique we had a learning curve and a gradual validation
