THE ENDOCANNABINOID SYSTEM **INDUCING HOMEOSTASIS**

omeostasis refers to the processes and reactions that our body utilizes to actively maintain a constant internal environment. Some examples of systems within our bodies that require this constant balancing include: oxygen levels, hydration, and body temperature. Disturbances to this balance can lead to diseases. Examples: epilepsy, stroke, arthritis, Crohn's disease, obesity and cancer. Our body's endocannabinoid system naturally produces cannabinoids that regulate the biochemical processes which help to maintain homeostasis. However, our bodies do not produce enough cannabinoids on their own and we must incorporate phyto cannabinoids (plant-based cannabinoids) to help our body obtain homeostasis.
