Importance of rotativity of Etanercepte administration sites for good clinical response to treatment

The present work aims to demonstrate the importance of the rotation of the injection sites to maintain the response to treatment with Etanercept, an immunobiological drug with anti TNF action, that is applied subcutaneously and is indicated in cases of psoriasis refractory to other treatments. This study shows a possible lack of response to the treatments after consecutive applications in the same anatomical site.
