Poster guidelines:

- The size of the poster ought to be: 40" x 59" or 1X1.5 Sq.Mts.
- Space your info proportionally: divide your poster either horizontally or vertically into three or four sections, and place your materials inside those areas.

- Use massive text (your text ought to be a minimum of 18-24 pt; headings 30-60 pt; title >72pt).
- Choose colours fastidiously and listen to distinction.
- Cropping, Margins and Spacing: All edges and margins ought to be straight and even. do not overcrowd space and be attentive to balance from top to bottom and from the aspect margins. Organize your components into columns.
- White space: (the space not lined with text or graphics): Not an excessive amount of (or the viewer's eye can wander). Not deficient (or you will confuse and overwhelm your viewer)
- Posters ought to have the subsequent info.
- Title (with authors and affiliations)
- Introduction / Objectives / Aims
- Methods
- Results
- Conclusion
- References
- Acknowledgements
- Contact info
- Posters ought to stimulate discussion, don't provide a long presentation. Therefore, keep text to a minimum, emphasize graphics, and ensure each item in your poster is important.
- Good quality of the ink is to be used to print the poster.
- No computers or additional aids may be used throughout a poster presentation.
- Poster ought to be placed at the assigned places a pair of hours before the poster session and might be removed at the top of the day.
- Keep your poster presentation to ~15 minutes per visitor/judge (10 min discussion & five min question session).
- Each poster may be bestowed by most a pair of presenters throughout the poster analysis.
- Try to not stand directly before of your poster, enable alternative scientists to look at the whole poster. Stand to the aspect.
- Carry your poster to the meeting, exploitation cannular packaging or a portfolio case. Don't mail your poster to the conference headquarters or to the meeting website.

Guidelines:

Applicants must:

- Submit associate abstract as 1st author through the Abstract Submission System
- Submit the supporting materials listed below
- Be willing to present his/her work at PULSUS conferences
- Supporting Materials (in English):
- Copy of passport (1st page as proof of age)

- Copy of abstract submitted as 1st author
- Completed application form
- Updated resume
- All submissions should be in English.
- All the presentations should be in oral form only.
- Each young scientist is required to make a brief presentation (15 minutes) about his/her research work before the Organizing committee at the event. This may be followed by 5 minutes question-answer session.
- The awards are given for outstanding contributions made by the Young scientists on work done.
- Scientific societies of national/international standing, university faculties, postgraduate departments or research institutions may also make nominations of eligible candidates
- The nomination shall be made in the prescribed format. Soft copy (in MSWord only), along with all supporting documents of the candidate through email to (Applicants are requested to send a copy of all documents to with the subject line: Young Scientist Award)
- Documents for Nomination:
- Recommendation letter
- Details of candidate (Name; DOB; Nationality; Gender; present designation, department; Summarize the most significant work of the nominee on which the recommendation is based).
- One candidate is eligible to present only one talk under the young scientist award category, and the presenter should be either the 1st author or co-author of the work.
- Papers will be accepted based on the uniqueness and novelty of the work.
- Organizing committee is liable to reject the paper at any point if any claims are made on the novelty of the work
